The Musician is an integral part of the pastoral staff and will minister with a heart of service to God.

Job description:

- The Musician will be the Pianist, Organist, and Choir Director for weekend liturgies, school Masses, and other holy days/celebrations.
- Preparing music selections, building and maintaining repertoire in traditional and contemporary traditions according to Roman Catholic liturgy.
- Recruit, prepare, and train Parish music groups and volunteer cantors.
- Preparing worship aids and supplements for congregational singing as needed.
- Ensuring proper copyright usage for all printed materials.
- Overseeing Wedding and Funeral Mass music.
- Prepare, review, and maintain the music budget.
- Maintaining musical instruments and sound equipment.

Requirements for the Role:

- Skilled pianist, organist, and choir director/vocal coach
- Ability to work effectively with other employees and volunteers
- Knowledge of the Catholic liturgy and directing sacred music in the Catholic Church is preferred.
